



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 60 inches/153 cm  
Width: 10 inches/25cm

## GAUGE

10 cm/4 in. = 15.5 sts and 15.5 rows in pattern **after blocking** .  
While gauge is not important, differences in gauge may require more yarn to get designed length.

## MATERIALS

2 x100g Artesano Aran (144yds/132m per 100g) (I had approximately 2meters left, so you might need a 3rd skein.)

6.25mm/10.5 US knitting needles  
4 safety pins  
1 tapestry needle

Aimili is a lace scarf, knitted with a slightly modified horseshoe pattern. The horseshoe pattern is a basic Shetland lace pattern and is a great pattern to use if you want to have a scallop edging. The scarf is worked in 2 pieces and grafted together at the center, so the scallops are on both ends. If you don't join in the scarf in the middle, you will not have the scallop edge on both ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

K		Knit (for charted instructions, knit on right, purl on wrong side)
P	-	Purl(for charted instructions, purl on right, knit on wrong side)
wyif, s1	V	With yarn in front, slip 1
Yo	O	Yarn over
s2kp	^	Slip 2 sts together as if to knit, knit 1, pass the 2 slipped sts over the knit sts

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 39 stitches. Follow written or charted instructions.

### Written

Row 1-5: wyif, s1, knit to end

Row 6, 8, 10, 12: wyif, s1, k3, p until last 4 stitches, k4

Row 7: wyif, s1, k3, \*k1, yo, k3, s2kp, k3, yo\*; repeat \* to \* 3 times, k5

Row 9: wyif, s1, k3, \*k2, yo, k2, s2kp, k2, yo, k1\*; repeat \* to \* 3 times, k6

Row 11: wyif, s1, k3, \*k3, yo, k1, s2kp, k1, yo, k2\*; repeat \* to \* 3 times, k7

Row 13: wyif, s1, k3, \*k4, yo, s2kp, yo, k3\*; repeat \* to \* 3 times, k8

Row repeat is highlighted in grey.

Written and Charted

Repeat rows 6 -13 until scarf is half desired length. (Scarf shown has 14 repeats for each half for a total of 28 repeats)

Place stitches on stitch holder.

Work second half to match first half.

**FINISHING**

Cut yarn so that length is approximately, 4 times the width of the scarf. Place the garter stitch edging (4 sts) on each safety pins. Thread tapestry needle.



With the right side up, graft the center 31 stitches first, taking care to leave at least 10 in tail. Turn the scarf over, so that the wrong side is facing up, place one side of the edging back onto the needles, graft with the wrong side up (so you have purl graft on the right side). Repeat for the other edge. Sew in loose ends and block.
